



About Bursaries

Each year, the Sudbury Community Foundation awards bursaries through several of their Named Funds. These bursaries are awarded for purposes, specified below. A committee reviews and assesses each application and makes funding recommendations to the Foundation's Board of Directors based on merit and available funding.

The application period is from April 1 to August 31. Application forms are attached and also available on the Foundation's website. Please submit completed applications to the Sudbury Community Foundation (957 Cambrian Heights Dr., Suite 200A, Sudbury, ON P3C 5S5), or send electronically to executive@sudburycf.ca, no later than August 31.

Successful applicants will be required to submit proof of acceptance to the educational institution specified in the application.

Coniston Community Bursary

Academic achievement and community involvement will be considered assets in the selection process. Adult learners and students of various abilities are encouraged to apply.

Criteria for Eligibility:

- **Citizenship:** Citizen of Canada
- **Residency:** Must be a current resident of Coniston
- **Academic Program:** Must be enrolled in their 2nd or 3rd year of a university or community college studying in the field of general arts, humanities, fine arts, languages, social sciences, or health sciences
- **Community Involvement:** Preference given to those demonstrating community involvement through past experiences, future plans for community projects and/or current interests or involvement in the town

Application Requirements:

- **Personal Statement:** A personal statement (500-1000 words) detailing the applicant's academic and personal achievements to date as well as information detailing community involvement and commitment to giving back in the future.
- **Letter of Recommendation:** One letter of recommendation from a professor or community leader who can speak to the applicant's character, academic successes, and community involvements.
- **Proof of Enrollment:** Proof of enrollment in the 2nd or 3rd year of one of the academic programs noted above at a recognized university or college.

Selection Process:

- **Review Committee:** A selection committee will review all applications based on the outlined criteria.
- **Scoring Criteria:**
 - Community Involvement: 40%
 - Commitment to Give Back: 10%
 - Academic Performance: 30%
 - Personal Statement & Letter of Recommendation: 20%
 - **Interviews:** Shortlisted candidates may be invited for an interview with the selection committee.

Award Details:

- **Monetary Value:** The bursary amount will set at **\$2,500** and awarded to the selected recipient.
- **Presentation:** The bursary may be presented at an official ceremony hosted by the Sudbury Community Foundation.
- **Reporting:** The recipient will be expected to provide a brief report on how the bursary has supported their academic and community goals within a year of receiving the award.
- **Application Deadline:** August 31
